DID YOU KNOW...

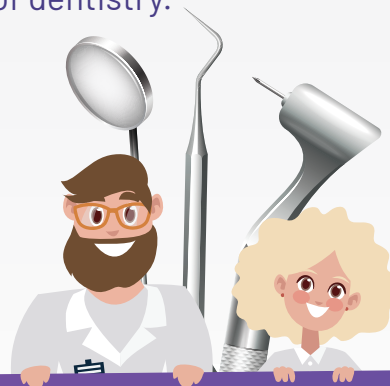
